

## **AUDITIONS**

1. **Be Early!** Each audition is only 10 minutes long so we will be moving quickly. If you're not there for your start time, you may get skipped. Being on time will allow you to relax and prepare.

2. **Be Prepared!** Before your audition, memorize your lines and song. At the audition, take some time to go over your lines and music selection. It's fun to see old friends, but use your waiting time wisely by focusing on your audition. Come dressed professionally and with comfortable footwear in case you're asked to dance, no costumes.

3. **Be Confident!** Introduce yourself to the panel when you're directed on stage. Even if your knees are shaking, let your personality shine by answering the panel's questions with more than one word responses. Anything you can do to leave an impression is helpful. Don't worry about being nervous. Just about everyone is nervous. Do your best to smile and have a good time.

## **REHEARSALS**

1. **Be Supportive!** We've all heard the saying, "There are no small parts, only small actors". If you don't get the role you want, remember that the panel has lots of actors to choose from. Be a good friend to everyone in the cast by lifting them up with compliments. You are important to the production!

2. **Be Committed!** We know how busy everyone is but we ask that if you choose to audition and receive a role, rehearsals are your top priority. If you are playing a fall sport or have lots of other activities during production time, we ask that you wait until your schedule is more free to audition for a production. It's not fair to your cast mates when you're not there for rehearsal.

**\*\*If you have rehearsal conflicts, talk with the Directors, there may be a backstage spot that you can fill.**

3. **Be Flexible!** The Director may have to change rehearsal times or plans, just roll with it!

4. **Be Professional!** Listen to your Directors, and don't distract your cast mates by talking when you should be listening. Treat the facility with respect, we are guests. Treat sets, props and costumes with respect, they are expensive to replace.

5. **Be Your Best!** Give 100% effort at all rehearsals and performances. Everyone makes mistakes, don't dwell on yours, just learn and do better next time. HAVE FUN!
